



Nominations for the Liddane Award – 2006

Bill Liddane was a tireless soldier in the fight against auto theft. In 1985, he was instrumental in the establishment of the HEAT® Program, a confidential, toll-free tip line for reporting auto theft information that has so far rewarded over \$2.9 million in rewards to tip callers and aided in the recovery of over \$42 million in stolen property. In an effort to recognize and honor these accomplishments after his death in 1999, the Liddane Award was created.

We are now seeking nominees for the 2006 award. The award will recognize someone who has made a significant contribution to the fight against auto theft in Michigan. As the HEAT® program already provides awards for outstanding law enforcement officers, we would be particularly interested in recognizing those in the insurance industry, community groups, private enterprise or government with this award.

The form may be typed or completed by hand, as it is the quality of the nominee's accomplishments that will be evaluated, not the quality of the submission form. Please try to be as descriptive as possible when relating why you believe the award should go to the individual nominee. The winner will be notified in early October and will be recognized at our Anniversary Breakfast on Tuesday, October 24, 2006 in the Olympia Club at the Joe Louis Arena in Detroit.
